MINUTES of the annual general meeting of the members of the **Gymnastics Federation of Bermuda** (the "Company"; held by way of a Zoom meeting on Friday, 15 November 2024 at 8 pm, (the "Meeting").

1. Chairperson

1.1. Julie Bortoli acted as chairman of the Meeting ("Chairman") and as secretary. ("Secretary").

2. Notice

2.1. The notice convening the Meeting was taken as read, and the Chairperson reported that notice had been given to the Members and that a quorum was present.

3. Previous Minutes

3.1. The minutes of the 2023 annual general meeting held on 15 December 2023 were read and confirmed as a true and accurate record of the proceedings.

4. Appointment of Auditor

4.1. It is **RESOLVED** pursuant to the provisions of Section 88(1) of the Companies

5. Financial position for the year ended August 31, 2024

5.1. Ms. Bortoli discussed that Federation revenue consists of Membership fees and Grants while expenses are for Meet costs, coaching fees, and federation fees (PAGU & FIG). Ms. Bortoli went on to explain how the fees are calculated and reminded everyone the methodology was agreed upon when the Federation was set up as an independent body. The discussion then focused on what the Federation does on the island for gymnastics. The members were reminded the Federation can provide athlete and coaches courses & training along with supporting athletes at Internation competitions such as Carifta which Bermuda athletes will be travelling to in November. IN addition, Y&S and BOA deal directly with the Federations to provide funding. BOA funding is for junior & senior athletes competing and International Festivals. Currently we do not have any athletes at this level.

6. Election of Directors

6.1. It was **RESOLVED** that:

- 6.1.3. the Board be authorised to fill the vacancies arising on the Board as and when it deems fit.
- 6.1.4. the Board be authorised to appoint Alternate Directors as and when it deems fit; and
- 6.1.5. the Directors serve without remuneration for the time being.

7.1. It was **RESOLVED** that any and all duly authorised actions taken by the directors and officers for and on behalf of the Company to date be and are ratified and confirmed.
